Minutes of the Meeting

In today's meeting mainly the allocation of Budget under UAC XII Plan and the tentative budget proposal by the Planning Board was discussed in which Depts of Botany, Chemistry, Maths, English, Hindi, Pol. Science and Geology put up their proposals.

As per the guidelines of UAC, grants under General Development Assistance (GDA) will be provided as a Block Grant with the flexibility to incur expenditure as per the needs of the college. Percentage of allocation under Grant-in-Aid General (31) and Capital Assets (35) will be on the ratio of 20:80 basis.

The objectives of the grant are:

1. To provide grants to the college for strengthening basic infrastructure, and meet their basic needs like books & journals including book banks, scientific equipment, teaching aids & sports facilities.
2. To provide assistance for extension/renovation of existing buildings.
3. To provide assistance to colleges catering to the needs of students belongs to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy) / minority, PH & economically deprived students.

4. To encourage outreach activities, adult & continuing education
5. To provide facilities for women
6. To support competence building initiatives and promote multicultural activities
7. To accommodate innovative ideas to influence teaching, research, academic excellence and societal growth.

The eligibility criteria for getting these grants were also discussed.

Another issue discussed in the meeting was introduction of CBCS & semester system at UG level also from the current session, i.e. 2015-16. Controller of Exam Dr A K Gupta disseminated the main points of this system among members of IQAC, such as the number of core subjects to be offered by a student, credit system, % of marks in Internal and External Exam - 30% for Internal and 70 marks for External Exam.

There would be grading, instead of marks in evaluation.

Examination forms would be submitted on line.

Percentile system would be adopted w.e.f this session.

The proposal to purchase more computers for central computer lab was also discussed in the meeting.

The chairperson of IQAC Principal Prof V A Bourai informed the IQAC members that as a follow up to the discussions held with Senior Manager (Finance) of Reliance Jio Infocom Ltd., the process of installing data services in the college campus will be initiated soon.

A proposal to purchase instant high speed scanner was also discussed in the meeting.
